Arrival & Parking

The code provided for Gate Four to access the dinghy park is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of Reception in the main building entrance.

Please put your boats in zones 3, 4 & 5 in the dinghy park – see attached site plan.

Access the site through Gate Four, drop off your dinghy and launching trolley, put the road trailer in the area indicated, then park the vehicle in the main gravel car park over the road opposite Reception. Vehicles will not be permitted in the dinghy park.

Lockers & Changing Rooms

Lockers are available in the changing room corridor. Keys may be obtained from Reception with a £10 cash deposit, which is returned when the key is returned to Reception. We kindly request that no kit bags or personal items are left in the changing rooms so as not to inconvenience others and for your security.

Catering

The cafeteria is open from 08:00 serving breakfast, lunch, snacks, hot and cold drinks. Packed lunches or baguettes/sandwiches may be ordered from the cafeteria to take on the water. The closing time will depend on the days racing and social events.

Reception
