

MEMBERSHIP EXPLAINED

Membership Type	Description
New Members Joining Fee	Payable by all new members and previous members whose membership has lapsed, i.e. fees not paid before 30 th April
Student Membership	Available to students aged 16+ in full time education and with a valid Student ID card. Under 18's will require parental consent
Single Hander Boat Membership	Available to owners of a single - handed dinghy
Standard Membership	Available to owners of double handed dinghies, power boats or trailer sailors who wish to use the facilities to launch
Storage	Available to single hander boat or standard members, and can only be taken out with membership
Harbour dues	Annual or Seasonal Portland Harbour Permits as per list below
All members receive: 10% discount in cafeteria, use of car parks, use of showers, changing rooms and social facilities	

HARBOUR FEES 2023

The following Port and Harbour Dues are applicable to recreational vessels, workboats, fishing vessels and pleasure craft for hire, less than 24 metres in length (small vessels).

A separate charging regime will apply to commercial and trading vessels and those which are not small vessels and Personal Watercraft (PWC).
