



29er UK Class COVID Regulations Version 1 dated 7 October 2020

1. To ensure the safety of all attending our events, it is critical that you do not travel to the event if any of the following apply:
 - a. you have any symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
 - b. you have tested positive for coronavirus in the last 14 days
 - c. you live with someone who has symptoms or tested positive in the last 14 days
 - d. you have been in contact with someone in the last 14 days who has symptoms and has not yet had a negative Covid-19 test result
 - e. you have been told to self-isolate
 - f. You or your support personnel have arrived in the UK in the last 14 days from a country that is not on the FCDO list of countries that are exempt from having to self-isolate when arriving in England – see GOV.UK: how to self-isolate when you travel to the UK <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-travel-corridors>
 - g. you live in an area with Covid-19 special measures that prevent you from travelling to the venue. For the avoidance of doubt, our events are not an Elite Competition as defined by DCMS for England.

2. If you cannot attend for any of these reasons set out in para 1, your entry will be refunded and you will not be penalised in any Class Squad selection. N.B. The RYA have separately stated that the same applies to the RYA Youth Squad.

3. You are required to register with any venue track and trace system as you enter the host venue site and you must apply social distancing and the “rule of 6” at all times. The host venue will exclude anyone who does not comply from the site.

4. You are required to comply with any additional rules put in place by the host venue.

5. It is a requirement that all sailors have up to date parent / guardian contact information on ourclubadmin and, if parents / guardians of under-18 sailors leave the WPNSA site, in loco parentis information must be provided to membership@29ersailing.org.uk

6. A breach of these regulations shall not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This amends rule 60.1(a) {DP}

7. It is recommended that all attendees at the event wear face masks or equivalent at all times ashore when at the event.

8. It is recommended that only one parent / guardian per sailor (not counting volunteers) comes on site at the venue.
