Arrival & Parking

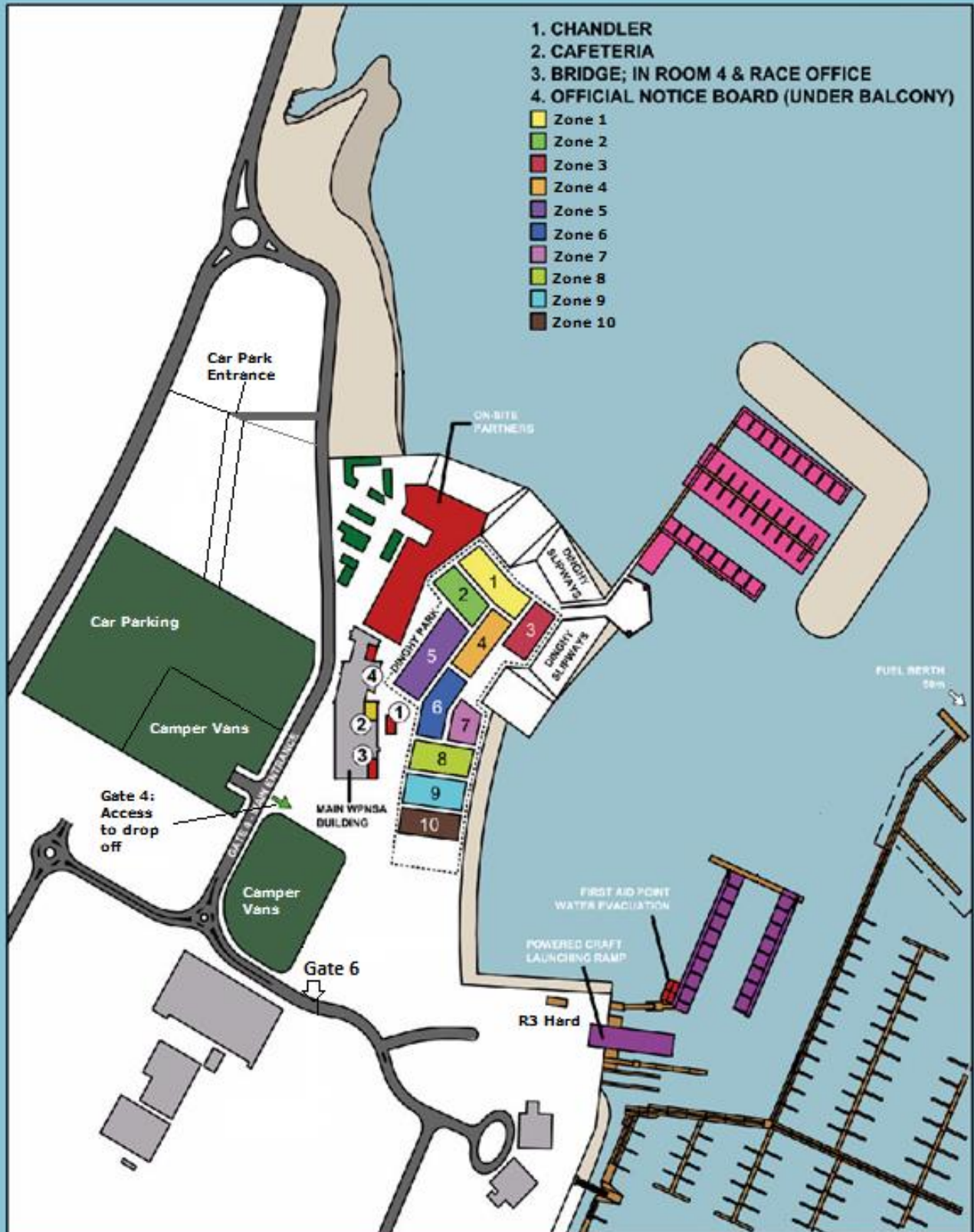
Catering
